Weekly Report

Tim Indians continues to hold a comfortable lead with a 2.55 ppgi over the Colts 2.47 and Yankees 2.45. I would have to estimate that each .01 is like a game in MLB, so the Indians have a 8 game lead. The Colts had a torrid stretch in late August but have since cooled a bit. At one point Rios, Dunn, Cargo, and Hayward had combined for 180 points in a 7 day stretch. The Indians have been so consistent all year and will be tough to catch.

The Shortage / Overage chart this week uses 2.35 as the factor for teams in a shortage situation. This is the amount that will be used at season's end to determine draft order. Next year it moves to 3.0.

As far as the teams with underages, the Mets have made a massive move with their IP shortage using the surfing of starting pitchers having shaved about 240 points off and getting it down to 96. The Cardinals are down as well, to 173.

Explanations of some columns ... won't be needed next year

The negative save calculation, in the pitchers' scap column, takes into account the 30 saves cap rule and makes the team scoring on the left different than the Yahoo scoring once a team gets to its 31st save. Each save over 30 is worth minus 4. This sheet does not take into account the individual pitcher with over 30 saves, at least not yet. For example, Brain Wilson of Reds has 31 saves. Now the brp column for Chris Reds shows a positive value of +8. brp means best rp, meaning the rp on your team with the most saves over 30. Each save over 30 is worth 8 points, 4 for the save and 4 more to negate the scap adjustment. Only one pitcher on your team can burp. Thus, Chris Reds has a plus 4 adjustment to his team total, that is, -4+8 = +4.

The RP column now shows the RP's who are at or approaching 31 saves. Once they get to 31 the the brp column starts increasing. Be aware that these saves beyond 30 are with the same BB3000 team before they count. If you got Nunez in a deal now with 29 saves, and he got 6 more bringing his MLB total to 35, you would not get brp points because he only got 6 saves with your team.

The new govr column is games over at any position, that is, more than 162 games played at C,1B,2B,3B,SS,CF,DH, or 324 games at OF. Each game over results in a minus 5 penalty which is calculated into the new AdjT column, or the final official standings, Adjusted Total. Does anyone have an overage at any position yet? I would begin looking at Gord's Senators with 892 games played already. OK, just looked. He has only 42 games left at 3rd base, and 45 games left at DH. Please report any overages you find. Just like you should monitor your opponents rosters, also check for this and email me if you find anyone going over. Hopefully no one will have any overages and this column remains zero for all teams.

The ppgi column to the left is Points Per Game + Innings. The season innings cap is 1450 and the season games cap is 162 x 9 = 1458. Right now each offensive game is worth more than each inning pitched on a league wide basis, at 2.4 to 2.3.
